TOEFL*	100+	Direct Entry - you will be eligible for admission without further English study.
TOEFL*	80-99	Required to take EGAA or ELP 8-week course.
IELTS	7.5+	Direct Entry - you will be eligible for admission without further English study.
IELTS	6.5-7.0	Required to take EGAA or ELP 8-week course.
PTE	68+	Direct Entry-you will be eligible for admission without further English study.
PTE	59-67	Required to take EGAA or ELP 8-week course.
Duolingo	125+	Direct Entry - you will be eligible for admission without further English study.
Duolingo	105-124	Required to take EGAA or ELP 8-week course.
